TRANSMITTAL MESSAGE

Honorable Mayor, Members of the City Council and Residents of Jurupa Valley:

On behalf of the City of Jurupa Valley staff I am proud to transmit the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 to Fiscal Year 2027-2028 Capital Improvement Program (CIP). The CIP is a five-year planning instrument used to identify and coordinate the financing and timing of public improvements. All projects presented in this budget have been carefully examined to ensure the community's capital improvement needs are met both now and in the future. The multi-year plan identifies improvements to the City's roads, drainage, traffic signals, and other capital infrastructure.

The five-year CIP includes 73 projects, totaling approximately \$174,264,056. The proposed capital budget for Fiscal Year 2023-24 includes 45 projects and \$72,587,694 in available funding. These projects are scheduled to begin design, construction and/or be completed in Fiscal Year 2023-24. The revenue estimates, although conservative, are strictly estimates. The actual amount of funds available for construction will vary based on the state of the economy. Projects slated for subsequent years in the program are for planning purposes only and do not receive expenditure authority until they are allocated funding in a future capital budget.

CIP projects are intended to enhance the safety and quality of life for all citizens in the City. The City Council will be updated throughout the year on the status of the projects. The following is a list of some highlighted projects contained in the CIP:

- Sunnyslope Area SR2S Sidewalk Gap Closure
- Van Buren Blvd. from Etiwanda Ave to Bellegrave Ave
- Granite Hill Area Safe Routes To School Sidewalk Gap Closure
- 2023-2024 Pavement Rehabilitation (ARPA) Project

City staff worked with the City Council to identify the City's capital needs for each fiscal year and evaluated anticipated funding availability. The focus of the CIP is to combine a comprehensive planning document that identifies revenues with the capital projects expenditure budget. The document also augments the existing capital projects budget information and facilitates the long-range capital projects planning process.



The Fiscal Year 2023-24 to Fiscal Year 2027-28 Capital Improvement Program requires a total team effort of both City staff and the City Council. I would like to thank staff and the City Council for all of the contributions that were made in developing the capital budget that will serve as the blueprint for Jurupa Valley's future.
