CITY OF JURUPA VALLEY FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY / REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS

The City of Jurupa Valley is a recipient of CDBG funds from the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The primary objective of the CDBG program is "the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing, a suitable environment and expanding economic opportunities principally for persons of low- and moderate-income." To date, the 2020 Federal budget has not been approved; however, for planning purposes, the City anticipates receiving \$1,200,000 in CDBG funds for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021).

The City of Jurupa Valley is free to select from a range of eligible activities established by HUD for the use of CDBG funds. Eligible activities include social service programs (i.e., public services) provided the majority of program beneficiaries are low- and moderate-income residents, as defined by HUD. Funding for public service programs is limited to a budget allotment established by the City that falls within CDBG program guidelines. The City has planned to make \$180,000 available for public services for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. The funding levels listed above are subject to modification once HUD publishes actual grant amounts. Funding levels may be increased or decreased by a uniform percentage (or other method) based on the final grant amount.

REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS

At this time, the City is accepting applications from interested, tax-exempt California nonprofit organizations currently providing or planning to provide eligible CDBG services within the City of Jurupa Valley during Fiscal Year 2020-2021. Interested/qualified organizations are invited to apply for public service programs funding. The CDBG application, along with additional information regarding the CDBG program as administered by the City of Jurupa Valley, is available for download from the City's website www.jurupavalley.org or upon request at Jurupa Valley City Hall located at 8930 Limonite Avenue, Jurupa Valley, CA 92509, during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
