What We Provide

In partnership with the California Department of Veteran Affairs, the County of Riverside Economic Deveolpment Agency, and the City of Jurupa Valley, Habitat for Humanity Riverside will continue to address the veteran housing crisis by building 26 new, energy efficient, single-family homes dedicated to veterans, reservists, and families of fallen. On the journey to home ownership, Veteran Partner Families will attend no-cost, educational workshops that range from financial literacy to health and wellness and complete a minimum of 500 hours of "Sweat Equity" per applicant.

Selection Process

HFH Riverside has an independent family Selection Committee that reviews and selects applicants based on need, ability to repay a mortgage loan, and willingness to partner with Habitat Riverside.

To be considered, Veteran applicants must:

- 1.Be a Veteran and submit a DD214 with an Honorable Discharge, an Active Service Member, or a Surviving Spouse, as defined by Cal Vet.
- 2. Live or work in Riverside County.
- 3. Be a first-time homeowner or cannot own a house within the past three years.
- 4. Be citizens or permanent residents of the United States.
- 5. Have a satisfactory credit history.
- 6. Demonstrate the ability to pay a long-term mortgage loan, down payment, and closing costs.
