

## Building Department Final Inspection & Certificate of Occupancy Requirements

## California Building Code (CBC) Sections 110.3.10 & 111.1

CBC 110.3.10 Final inspection. The final inspection shall be made after all work required by the building permit is completed.

**CBC 111.1 Use and occupancy**. No building or structure shall be used or occupied, and no change in the existing occupancy classification of a building or structure or portion thereof shall be made, until the building official has issued a certificate of occupancy therefor as provided herein. Issuance of a certificate of occupancy shall not be construed as an approval of a violation of the provisions of this code or of other ordinances of the jurisdiction.

The following matrix indicates with a checkmark which agencies must be contacted for approval **prior** to requesting a final inspection from the City of Jurupa Valley Building Department and/or prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

NOTE: Before the Building Inspector will sign for Final Approval, the Inspection cards shall first be signed off by each required (checkmark) department/division whether or not a field inspection is required. (The cards may be signed off at the public counter by the department/division representative.)

<sup>1</sup> On Tenant Improvements that already have power, the Building Department will sign off last, (after all Departments indicated above), to ensure compliance by all affected departments/divisions.

<sup>2</sup> If the site landscaping or parking were altered as part of the tenant improvement, call the Planning Department to determine if an Occupancy Inspection is required from them.

<sup>3</sup> Residential Custom Homes require Engineering/Public Works only if a grading plan was required or street improvements were installed via an encroachment permit.

4 Fire Department sign off only required when automatic fire sprinklers are required to be installed.
